Five years ago, Umatilla School District transitioned to Common Core State Standards and began preparation for the Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBAC). Through curriculum adoption, increased intervention, and continued staff development, we strive to provide all students a quality education. We are excited to see growth in SBAC results this year, and we expect this trend to continue. Our students, staff, and families are working hard to ensure all students have the best opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge on the SBAC tests. This year, we have increased specialization of our intervention programs to provide greater flexibility for beginning readers. In addition, we have increased access to technology which will

provide better interim assessments bearing resemblance to the SBAC tests.

We continue focusing our resources toward closing achievement gaps and extending learning opportunities for all students. You can help by monitoring your child's homework, having your child read aloud to you for 20 minutes each night, attending school activities, and making sure students are at school each day. We welcome the opportunity to build partnerships with families and the community to ensure all students reach their full potential.

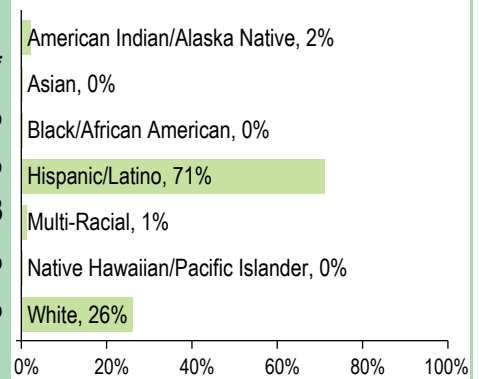

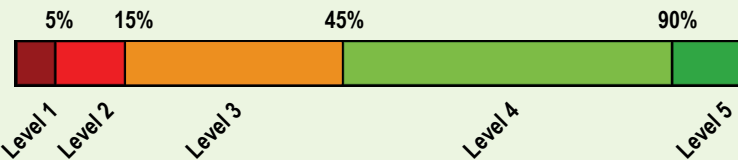
